As you navigate your ABO journey, keep these key milestones, timelines, and reminders in mind to help avoid delays + stay on track for ABO success.

Know Your Timeline

Review the dates of your upcoming AAO Annual/Winter Session, constituent meeting, or presentation.

We recommend submitting:

- initial scans **at least 3-4 months** before your presentation date.



Submit Initials Scans Early

As soon as a patient is identified as a potential ABO case, submit the initial scans.

Best time to Submit Initial Scans

Spring Boards: January - February
Winter Boards: September - October



Plan for Peak Season

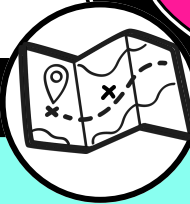
ABO volume is highest during:

- Spring Peak Season:** March - April
- 2nd Peak Season:** November - December



Turnaround Times

Peak Season: Allow up to 3 weeks
Standard/Non-Peak Season: 2 Weeks



Mark Your Models

Please indicate whether your submission is an **Initial or Final** ABO scan, especially when submitting multiple patients or sending Initials and Finals on the same day.

(We prefer separate lab Rx's for Initial + Finals scans)



Prepare for Detours

Models requiring bracket removal + special requests will require additional processing time + may incur extra fees.

Pay Toll + Rush Pass

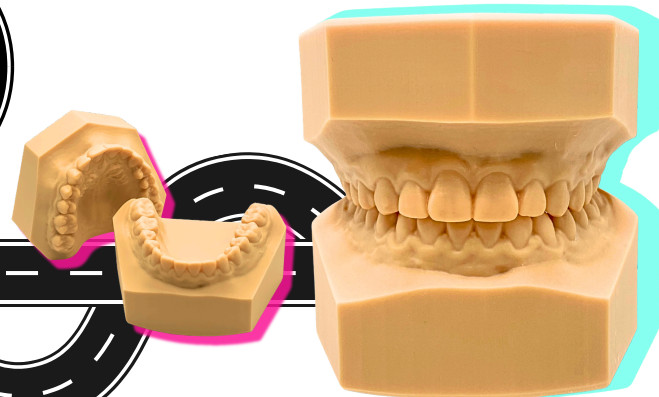
